## Anthony Lee Haney, 37

June 15, 1981 - Feb. 4, 2019

**NEW YORK** – Anthony Lee Haney was born in Harlan on June 15, 1981 to Sandra and Stewart Haney, and was baptized at Immanuel Lutheran Church. He graduated from Harlan Community School in 2000 where he was active in speech, drama and community service. During his school years he worked at Mickel's Restaurant, the Harlan Theatre, and various other locations. In middle and high school he actively participated in events



that allowed him to spark his love of travel. He visited Washington DC, Florida, California, and Europe. After graduating high school, to make sure he took a bit of his family with him, his mother gave him a rock stating "Imagine," inspiring him to do great things. He went on to graduate from Fordham University in New York where he majored in Finance, Business and Spanish. He was later employed as a digital analyst for several companies in New York City and San Francisco, while also running his own digital marketing company, Twenty-one, LLC.

Anthony loved to travel, and visited all the continents except Antarctica before he was 30 years old. Family and friends knew he was off on another adventure whenever he posted a picture of his Pan Am carry-on. Anthony was known for his wide smile and over the top, exuberant personality in which he never met a stranger and made all feel welcome.

Anthony died at his home in New York City on February 4, 2019 at the age of 37 years, eight months. His most faithful companion, of 12 years, was his beloved cat, 21, who followed Anthony to his final resting place on February 22, 2019.

Anthony is survived by his mother Sandra of Harlan; father Stewart of Irwin; sister Amanda of Louisville, KY; grandmother Lois Haney and uncle Steve of Apache Junction, AZ; and cousins Carol Oltman, Anna Wohnoutka, and Mary Doten, of Minneapolis, MN.
