
Remembrance

JOHN FORREST BROUHARD 78 1942-2021

PHOENIX, AZ - John Forrest Brouhard was born in Carroll, Iowa, the son of Forrest and Lavinia (North) Brouhard. He graduated from Harlan High School class of 1960. He pursued his education with a BA and an MA from the University of Iowa. After spending 2 years

John divided his time wintering with his daughter in Phoenix and summering in the small communities along the Missouri River, soaking up Iowa's natural beauty near the Loess Hills. He took pride in his tomatoes and his ability to identify birds. He could often be seen in a café, reading the paper with a cup of coffee in his hand, ready to talk to anyone who stopped by.
