

# Remembrance

### Ruth Thompson 94

### Nov. 7, 1942 - Aug. 25, 2019

HARLAN - Ruth Thompson was born on November 7, 1924 in Harlan to Christian Rold and Esther (Larsen). Ruth was the second of four children: Vivian, Paul, and Robert. Growing up on her parents' farm in Shelby County, Ruth experienced the Depression first hand; however, that didn't diminish her fond memories of her family, especially her siblings and parents whom she loved dearly. She remembered walking to the one-room schoolhouse in Monroe



She worked as a salesperson at JCPenny's and even won Miss Monrovia one vear.

After her sister's death, she moved back to Harlan to help her parents raise her niece, Connie. It was here in Harlan where she met Charles Haddon Thompson who had also recently arrived from California himself to build houses in Harlan and work on finishing the Altamont church. They were the first couple married in the newly finished church in 1955, and a year later, their son David was born.

After David's birth, Haddon went to work for the Bureau of Reclamation; this led them to move a few times including stops in Denver, Seattle, Sacramento, and Phoenix, before finally settling in Carmichael, CA where Haddon built the family a home. Ruth kept busy as an active member of the First Baptist Church of Carmichael (later renamed American River Community Church) and continued her membership until her passing. At church, she volunteered as the children's music director, sang in the Chancel Choir, played the piano and acted as wedding coordinator. She always made time to see her family in Iowa though; David remembers taking the three-day train ride between Sacramento and Omaha for many summers. When David entered high school, Ruth went back to college herself and eventually earned a degree in special education from Sacramento State. She became a Special Education teacher for children with moderate to severe mental and physical disabilities at the Starr King School. Although she gave up this job once her grandchildren, Jodee and Jared, were born, she continued as a substitute teacher for many years afterwards. Ruth continued to always put her family first, spending many summers babysitting for Jodee and Jared, taking them on many trips to the zoo, the park, and the library. She also took them separately on trips to Washington D.C. when they each reached the fifth grade. She always enjoyed traveling; her favorite trip was to Denmark to study family genealogy. After Haddon passed away in 2006, Ruth moved back to Harlan once again to be closer to David and Diane.

Although her memory gradually declined over the years due to Alzheimer's, she enjoyed seeing her family, including her great-grandchildren who came to visit her at Salem Lutheran Home. Her love of music never diminished even when most of the other memories had slipped away.

On August 25, 2019, at age 94, Ruth passed away She was preceded in death by her parents and her siblings; she is survived by her only son David (Diane) of Kimballton, her grandchildren Jodee (Arron Dixon) of Elk Horn, and Jared (Brittany) of Carmichael, CA, and her great-grandchildren, Cameron, Benjamin, and Abigail; and many nieces, nephews, and other family members.



### Verlee Shupe, 100

Jan. 15, 1919 - Sept. 18, 2019

HARLAN - Verlee Shupe, long-time resident of Harlan, went home to be with her Lord Wednesday, September 18. She was born on January 15, 1919 into one of the founding families of the Danish Baptist community near Fiscus. Her father was Magnus Jensen; her mother was Martha Nelsen, the only daughter of Jeppe and Else Nelsen. Verlee too was an only daughter, with brothers Dale, Wavne, Howard, and Harvey. The boys were al-



lowed to finish high school; she was not, instead helping to raise her younger brothers and then working on nearby farms to raise other children

At 19, she met Harold Shupe, a 24-year-old barber at a Baptist youth conference in northeast Iowa. They were married September 4, 1938 at one of the first weddings at what was then the new building for the Merrill's Grove Baptist Church. They first lived in Cedar Falls, Garner and Forest City, during which time Karen and Rosalie were born. When Harold entered the U.S. Navy at the end of 1943, Verlee and her two young daughters moved to Harlan to be near her parents. After the war, Harold joined her in Harlan, and a third child, David, was born.

For the next two decades Verlee raised her family and actively participated in Bethel Baptist Church. At the age of 50, she earned her GED. She also had a lifelong commitment to reading and memorizing Scripture, and from that she developed her own mission: hand-making verse packs for Scripture memorization for various Christian ministries, including the Navigators. Over seven decades she made over 60,000 verse packs, which were sent across the nation and the world. Because of the verse packs, she corresponded with and prayed for other Christians across the world. She was still making them when she was 99 years old and living in Elmcrest Assisted Living. Until the day before her death, she sewed her own clothes, had an active mind, and was a gregarious person far different from the shy farm girl of Fiscus.

Verlee was preceded in death by her husband Harold (2003) and their daughter Rosalie (2017). Surviving her are Karen (Larry) Wells of Jefferson, OR; son-in-law Paul (Rosalie) Powers, David (Della) Shupe of Saint Paul, MN; four grandchildren, six great-grandchildren and three great- great grandchildren.
