Jane Clara Goetzinger, 73

WESTPHALIA – Jane Clara Goetzinger, daughter of Edmund Nicholas and Sylvia Pauline (Gubbels) Goeser, was born January 30, 1946 in the Westphalia area where she spent her entire life. She was baptized, received her first holy communion and was confirmed at St. Boniface Catholic Church in Westphalia. In 1964, she graduated from St. Boniface Catholic School where she received the God, Home and Country Award.



On August 28, 1965, Jane married her high school sweetheart, Charles Joseph Goetzinger. Early in their married life, she enjoyed being a stay-at-home-mom, raising her four children: Regina Marie, Edward Nicholas, Sheila Anne, and Melissa Susan.
